The Listen Everywhere assisted listening smartphone app allows patrons to use their own phone as a listening device for events at the PAC. This app is compatible with wired headphones. Bluetooth headphones or hearing aids may be used, however, there will be an audio lag experienced when streaming live audio over Bluetooth. 




1. **Before entering the theater,** download the Listen Everywhere app on your smartphone.


2. **After you've taken your seat,** navigate back to your home screen & go to your Settings.



3. In Settings, go to Wi-Fi and select the ALS Secure network.




4. Type in password:
LSystem2020




5. Navigate back to the home screen & open the Listen Everywhere app.



6. When the app opens, a blue circle that says 'Venue Scan' will appear. Tap the circle.



7. Tap 'Skip Ad' when ad for the PAC pops up. Make sure your device is connected to headphones or Bluetooth hearing aids.



8. The app home screen will have two feed options. Use whichever feed sounds best to you. If using Bluetooth, make sure it's turned on in your phone settings.
